Australian Camp (2,100m/6,900ft) day tour starts after breakfast in the hotel in Pokhara. It's an hour drive to Kande, after which we will be hiking for another hour. But afterward, you will most definitely feel like you've accomplished something. The camp itself offers amazing Jungle scenery and you will be the Annapurna Mountain range from up close. The range consists of impressive peaks such as Annapurna South, Hiunchuli, Machhapuchhre, and LamjungHimal. The trek is best for those wishing to experience Nepal's mountain scenery as well as experience the ethnic culture within a short timeframe.
